**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT [REDACTED] PETITION FOR
REMOVAL FROM THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY**

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon the filing of the Petitioner/Defendant, [REDACTED], of his Petition for Removal from the Sex Offender Registry pursuant to Florida Statutes, §943.0435(11)(2025), and the Court having reviewed the contents of said Motion along with the Exhibits attached thereto, and being advised that the State of Florida and the Florida Department of Law Enforcement do not object to the relief sought therein, the Court finds as follows:

1. The Petitioner, [REDACTED], statutorily qualifies for removal from the Florida Sex Offender Registry based on the provisions of Florida Statutes, §943.0435(11)(2025).
2. The Court is satisfied that the Petitioner, [REDACTED], has not, since his release from all sanctions, been arrested for any felony or misdemeanor.
3. The removal of the Petitioner from the Florida Sex Offender Registry complies with the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006, and is not prohibited by federal law.

4. Based on the Exhibits attached to the Petition filed herein, the Court is further satisfied that the Petitioner is not a current or potential threat to public safety.

IT IS THEREFORE

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that [REDACTED] Petition for Removal from the Sex Offender Registry pursuant to Florida Statutes, §943.0435(11)(2025) is hereby **GRANTED**, and that [REDACTED] is no longer required to comply with the requirements for registration as a sexual offender in the State of Florida and that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement is hereby **ORDERED** and directed to immediately remove [REDACTED] name, image and information from the Florida Sex Offender Registry.
